We want to take the opportunity to assure you that we take the safety and well-being of your children, our employees, and you very seriously, and are taking precautions to make sure everyone feels safe.

Our normal practices and procedures have always included that our employees clean and sanitize frequently touched surfaces repeatedly throughout the day and that we do a deep sanitizing of the inflatables nightly. We have been and will continue to use EPA registered hospital grade disinfectants throughout our facilities to combat all ranges of viruses and germs.

As added measures, our employees monitor their temperatures and wear masks, and we asking everyone to frequently utilize the hand sanitizing pumps at our entrance for all those entering our facility, as well as throughout the building for your convenience. We also continue to ask that everyone, including adults, please remove your shoes and keep your socks on to keep our floors clean for the little ones that put their hands on the floor.

The Kangaroo Zoo supports the CDC, WHO and Utah Department of Health by recommending the following to keep our family friendly environments as clean and safe as possible:

- Frequently cleaning your hands with soap and water or by using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- And, if you or your child is not feeling well or is sick, please stay at home.
